

<p><b>Required Items</b></p> <p><b>Passport:</b> Check your expiration date to be sure it does not expire while you are in the DR.</p> <p><b>Tetanus:</b> Within the last 5 years.</p>	<p><b>Passport Information</b></p> <p>If you are going to the Dominican Republic, a Passport is required. If you do not have a <a href="#">Passport</a>, you need to start planning 8-12 weeks prior to your trip. The application may be picked up and/or filled out at the Clerk of Courts Office, or you may obtain one online by clicking on <a href="#">Passport</a>. There are different regulations for minors for registering for your passport, so please call ahead to the Clerk of Courts office to see what restrictions you might encounter if you are under the age of 18. You may need both parents present to sign.</p> <p>If you currently have a passport check the expiration date. <b>BE SURE</b> it does not expire during your trip. If it does you may become a missionary to the Dominican Republic or you may not be allowed to board the plane to the Dominican Republic</p>
<p><b>Do Not Bring</b></p> <p><b>DO NOT BRING ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:</b></p> <p>Jewelry, costly watches, iPod, mp3 players or cell phones, expensive cameras, game boys, CD players.</p> <p>NO blow dryers, curling irons etc. There is not enough power and it is too hot.</p>	<p><b>Luggage Information</b></p> <p>Luggage: You are allowed up to two (2) checked bags for the flight. One will be used for your items and the other will be used for supplies being transported to the DR. All luggage must have <b>YOUR HOME ADDRESS ON IT !!!!</b></p> <p>Weight Limit: 50 Lbs. per bag.</p> <p>Carry-on: Be sure that it meets all Airline requirements. If it does not, it will be considered luggage and an additional charge to you will be applied.</p> <p>Boxes: Any boxes sent must have "Colegio Cristiano Logos" written on them, and boxes must be numbered 1 of ?, 2 of ?, etc.</p>
<p><b>Your Water Bottle</b></p> <p><b>It is important to label your water bottle. You will use your water bottle throughout the day while you are working. You will also fill your water bottle in the evening so you will have fresh water to brush your teeth with.</b></p> <p><b>It is very important that you remember you can only drink the bottled water provided for you. You can and will get sick if you drink the tap water.</b></p>	

## What to Pack

### Work Clothing

3 or 4 painter, baker, hospital or other lightweight pants (must be past the knee)  
 4 T-shirts, short sleeve shirts or blouses  
 1 pair work gloves  
 1 pair of work shoes  
 1 hat to protect your head from SUN (close to the equator) to be worn at work  
 PLEASE LABEL ALL CLOTHING WITH A PERMANENT PEN IN LARGE LETTERS. The soap used will wash out your name if not done dark enough.  
 LAUNDRY WILL BE DONE EVERY 3 TO 4 DAYS PLEASE PLAN ACCORDINGLY.

### Other Items to Pack

Flashlight	Disposable Camera
Pillow	2 Old towels & washcloths
Sun Glasses	Chap stick
Bible	Medications
Drink Bottle	Box of Handi-Wipes
Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothbrush etc)	Mosquito Repellent
2 Old towels & washcloths	2 Old sheets Light blanket (Jan-March)
Prescription medicine	Sunscreen #30 or higher
Something for sun burn	Spending money for souvenirs \$50-\$60

### Other Clothing

1 Swimsuit, Girls PLEASE one piece and modest  
 1 beach towel  
 Girls 1 pair dress slacks, (no jeans) and a blouse to be worn to Church  
 Guys - Dress slacks and sport shirt with collar for Church  
 1 pair DRESS SHOES for Church  
 Modest shorts for sport activities - Girls must be to the middle of the knee  
 1 pair of flip-flops for shower use only  
 1 pair tennis shoes - sports, walking, and other places  
 2 pairs of jeans to be worn in the evening  
 3 T-shirts to be worn in the evenings  
 GIRLS CLOTHING MAY NOT BE TIGHT AND NO TANK TOPS

### In Your Carry-on

Change of underclothes in case your luggage does not arrive.  
 Snack items and handi wipes.

### Food Items to Bring

3 Packages of Gator-Aid  
 1 Large Box of Your Favorite Cereal  
 Jar of crunchy peanut butter or can of Spam lite
